This week one of our Pre Schoolers has sparked an interest in Fire fighters within the setting.

This has led to the children independently building a fire engine using our large loose parts.

We have then developed the children's role playing by modelling how to call the fire brigade and setting up fire rescue scenarios.

The children have also brought their own ideas which included putting out the fires by using different lengths of piping, rescuing pets from inside burning building and using a fireman's lift!
