Dear Parents & Carers,

I'd like to warmly welcome everyone back to school for this new academic year. A special welcome to all our new families, we look forward to working with you and watching your children flourish here at St Clare's. I hope you all had a wonderful break over the summer, the children have been telling us about all the lovely experiences they've had and came back happy and ready to learn on Tuesday. I'm thrilled to say all classes including our wonderful new Reception children in Australia class have settled in beautifully.

You may have seen on the news concerns about the presence of Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) found in some schools; forcing them to close. Our school recently had an inspection from the diocese and no RAAC was found so I'm thrilled to confirm we are not affected.

We are delighted to welcome Mrs Beattie, Mr Gates, Mr Varey and Miss Blythin to our staffing team. Mrs Beattie has worked at St Clare's in the past and has rejoined us as a TA in South America (Year Two). Mr Gates is also a returning member of staff having previously worked as a teacher here. He has returned in a different capacity as our Forest School teacher and is very excited to offer Forest School provision to all the pupils over the coming weeks and months. Mr Varey joins us from CEPD as our new Sports coach. He has a wealth of knowledge and skills with a particular passion for football. Again, Mr Varey will be working with all the children providing them with excellent PE. Miss Blythin joins us in Australia class as a 1:1 support assistant.

With school budgets needing to be stretched ever further, it is imperative that I inform you we already subsidise trips heavily and if parents don't make their contribution then there is a risk that trips will no longer be able to go ahead. This would be an incredible shame as the children benefit hugely from the enrichment trips we offer. If you are experiencing any financial difficulty or need to discuss a payment plan, please talk to the office.
