Fixed Penalty Notices (Fines)

As a result of recent register and attendance inspection by the local authority, all absences requested from Wednesday 1st November 2023, that are a minimum of 10 sessions (or 5 school days) and are classified as an un-authorised absence during the current term, will now receive a Fixed Penalty Notice (fine) from Cheshire West and Chester Council.

The current amount of the fine is £60 per parent/ carer, per child and is to be paid within 21 days. This will rise to £120 per parent/carer per child after this date and will still need to be paid within 28 days.

Absences include unauthorised holidays, persistent absences with no medical evidence and persistent late marks after the register has closed (after 9.20am) as this indicates a missed session.

On Wednesday 11th October, the children will be celebrating and saying 'thank you' for all our Harvest during Mass in St Clare's Church at 9.30am.

We are hoping to collect foods (tinned or packet) which can be donated to our local foodbank.
