I can't believe that the half term break was already three weeks ago! School has been so busy with all the extracurricular events including swimming, football and hockey tournaments, a remembrance service, the anti-bullying workshops and Children in Need to name but a few.

The swimming lessons have been a great success and we have settled into a good routine with children making great progress. Whilst the heater in the pool put it out of action for two days at the start of the week, I'm pleased to say it is all back up and running and we will hopefully have no further technical issues for the remainder of the time we have the pool. Please remember lessons will finish on Friday 1st December.

Our Year Six pupils who have not had an opportunity to swim are invited to bring their swimwear to school on Tuesday 28th November so they can get into the pool for an hour. This will still be overseen by the instructor, lifeguard and school staff.

We have used AmaSing as our provision in Years Five and Six for the Autumn Term whilst the teachers have time out of class for lesson planning. Feedback from pupils and parents has not been particularly positive. It is important that we respond to the feedback we get so feel that the children would benefit from precision music teaching again at this time. The school orchestra we previously had posed its own problems and generated negative feedback from children and parents. However, I am delighted to announce that we have been able to secure a contract with Music 4 Life who will be teaching instruments to the children in Years Five and Six from January. All the children will be able to experience a range of instruments over the coming terms will all pupils learning the same instrument at the same time. In Spring Term they are going to start by learning the ukelele.
