### Lache Larder

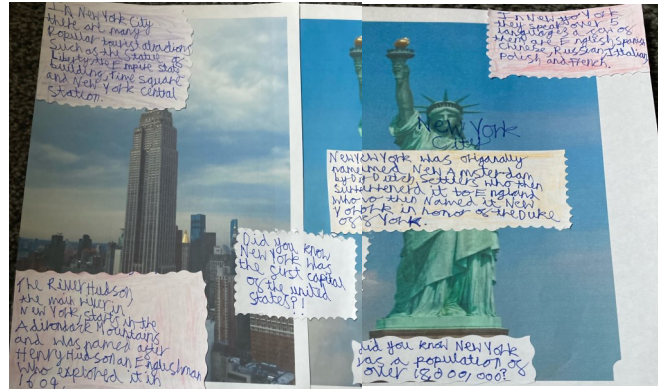
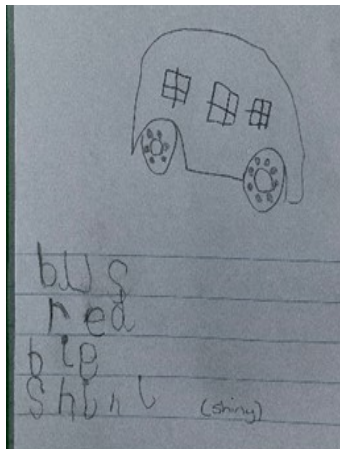
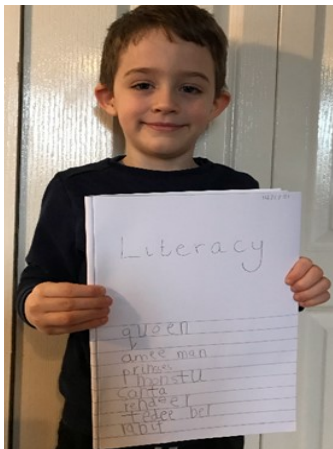
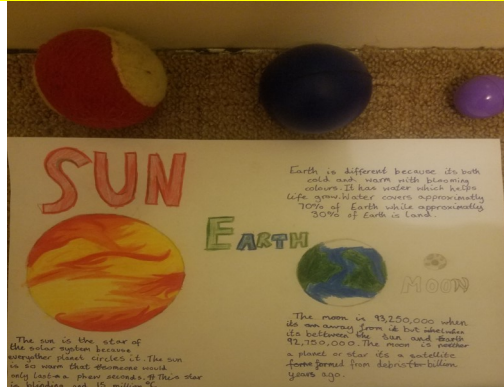
The Lache Larder is a social supermarket that is open on Wednesday & Friday's 2.00-3.00pm.

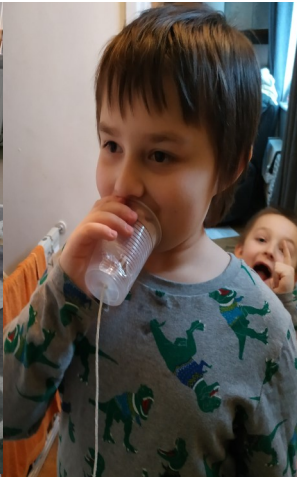

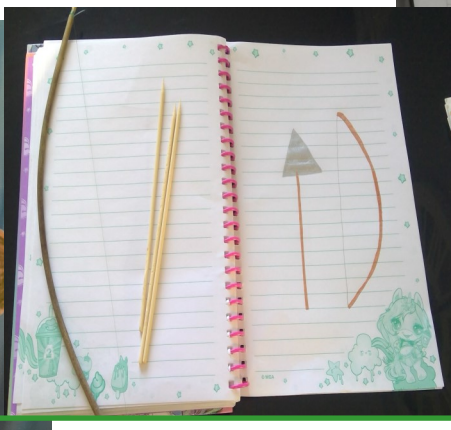
